Our Natural Slate Walling is available in two types. Cut Slate Walling is easier to build as most pieces are roughly block shaped with up to four sides sawn and the remainder split. Thin Slate Walling, shown here, is almost entirely split flat pieces. Both types come in random sizes in mixed shades of blue, grey and plum.



cotswold drystone walling

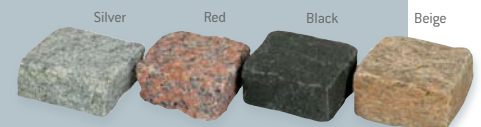
With its warm honey colour, our Cotswold Drystone Walling is genuine Cotswold stone ideal for dry building. If mortar is used, joints should be raked out for the best effect. The product is highly durable, although repeated hard frosts on wet retaining walls can occasionally affect the stone.



granite setts

Used as a paving material for centuries the rugged natural texture and exceptional durability of Granite Setts give them an air of solid permanence. Naturally occurring iron within the granite sometimes produces brown markings.
